2021/22 Flu Vaccinations

The eligibility criteria has again been extended this year to include all those aged 50 years and over on 31st March 2022.

We will be holding 'walk-through' vaccination clinics again this year, most of which will be at weekends in order to maintain our nursing capacity on weekdays. If you are unable to stand while waiting, removing your jacket and having the vaccination, please contact the surgery and we will make alternative arrangements. The vaccinations will take place in the waiting room. If you are not willing to expose your upper arm while other staff and patients are in the same room, please contact the surgery.

Patients aged 74 years and over will receive a first invitation by letter. Those aged 73 years and younger will receive a first invitation by text message (unless there is no mobile number available).

There are a number of ways you can help us with the smooth running of the clinics

- Please make every effort to attend at the date and time stated on your invitation. This will help with the flow of over 800 patients a day. However if your spouse/partner has been invited at a different time you are welcome to attend together.
- Our phones are extremely busy so please do not contact us if you cannot attend on the date of invitation. We will send another invitation in due course (if you have not declined).
- If you wish to decline this vaccination please reply 'DECLINE' to your text invitation or otherwise contact the surgery so we can update your records and we won't invite you again this winter.
- Please do not attend if you have a fever, cough, loss of taste or smell or have been in contact with a confirmed case of Covid-19.
- Please wear a mask.
- Roll up! Please ensure you wear appropriate clothing for the weather which is easily and quickly removed to expose your upper arm.
- The dispensary will be closed so please don't expect to be able to collect medications.
- These clinics are for flu vaccinations only. If and when Covid-19 booster vaccinations are rolled out, you will be contacted again.
